Scadbury Park Acorn Trail - Post 16

The meadow in front of you is quite heavily grazed by horses so the wildflowers you can see in it, such as **selfheal**, are those which can stand some trampling.



The meadow beyond the hedge behind you has longer grass which is food for *field voles*. At night *tawny owls* hunt for them.



Beetles and spiders provide food for **common shrew** and birds such as **crows**. Listen for **grasshoppers** by day, **crickets** in the evening.
